

## Campus Parking

### Permit Parking (Students, Faculty, and Staff)

All vehicles regularly parked on the Coral Gables campus must be registered with the UM Parking and Transportation office and have a current, valid, and appropriate University of Miami parking permit tag displayed.

Colors identify parking lots on campus. Park vehicles in designated spaces within lots where the entrance signage includes the color designator printed on your parking permit.

### Visitor Parking

#### Hourly Parking:

Hourly visitors may park at any coin meter or pay station lot on campus.

#### Short-Term Passes (one to seven days):

Visitors may obtain short-term passes at the day-pass machines located at Ponce de Leon Garage, Pavia Garage, and the Wellness Center. Day passes can also be purchased online at [www.miami.edu/parking](http://www.miami.edu/parking) via the "Click here to Access your UM Parking Account" link.

#### Long-Term Visitor Permits:

Visitors who do not qualify for other parking permits but who frequent the campus may apply for a long-term visitor permit based on availability from the Parking and Transportation Department.

### Bicycle Parking

We require all bicycles to be registered with the University of Miami Police Department and secured with a U-lock, which will be provided by the UM Police during the registration process. ### Zipcar Program

Zipcar is an innovative car-sharing program that provides the convenience of having a car on campus without the commitment of car ownership. Zipcar members, 18 years and older, may rent a vehicle for an hour, a whole day, or longer for a small fee that includes fuel, insurance, and maintenance. ## Hurry 'Canes Shuttle Service

The shuttle is available without charge to all University students, faculty, and staff and serves major areas of the University as well as the University Metrorail station, Rosenstiel campus, and area retail locations on the week-ends. It facilitates the use of perimeter parking lots and provides a convenient means of traveling around campus without using a personal vehicle. The shuttles run every six to eight minutes during class days and every 15 to 20 minutes all other times.

The Hurry 'Canes Shuttle does not operate on University of Miami designated holidays.


#### Sunset Shuttle
