UHealth – University of Miami Health System is a network with more than 1,200 physicians practicing in over 100 medical specialties and sub-specialties. UHealth doctors are recognized by their patients and local physicians as among the best in South Florida. More than 400 UHealth/Miller physicians are listed as “best doctors” in national rankings.

The groundbreaking research produced at the University of Miami’s Leonard M. Miller School of Medicine distinguishes UHealth as the only university-based medical center in South Florida. Founded in 1952 as Florida’s first medical school, the Miller School is home to some of the brightest minds in medicine.

The Miller School ranks in the top third among U.S. medical schools in total research funding awarded, with UHealth/Miller School physicians and scientists currently pursuing more than 1,600 projects with \$254 million in external grants and contracts. Many of these studies have led to clinical trials that directly change patient care. They work daily in 26 departments and more than 15 interdisciplinary centers discovering the keys to cures.

In addition to services provided on the medical campus in Miami, UHealth doctors treat patients at more than a dozen locations throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, and Collier counties.

UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI HOSPITAL

UHealth/Miller physicians work side by side with private-practice physicians at University of Miami Hospital, UHealth’s flagship acute-care hospital.

The 560 private-room facility is the only university-owned and -operated teaching hospital in Florida. At University of Miami Hospital, UHealth’s medical experts plan and deliver advanced care, investigate new treatments, and utilize the most advanced technologies available.

BASCOM PALMER EYE INSTITUTE

Bascom Palmer Eye Institute has been ranked the nation’s No. 1 eye hospital for 11 years in a row and also has earned an international reputation as one of the premier providers of eye care in the world. As the largest center of ophthalmic care, research, and education in the southeastern United States, Bascom Palmer is home to more than 250,000 patient visits and more than 12,000 surgical procedures each year.

SYLVESTER COMPREHENSIVE CANCER CENTER

Serving as the leader for cancer diagnosis, treatment, research, and education in South Florida, Sylvester integrates all cancer-related activities at the University of Miami. With more than 280 physicians and scientists, Sylvester provides unique, multidisciplinary cancer care organized in 15 site-specific disease groups, allowing Sylvester specialists to diagnose and treat nearly 6,000 new patients annually. As members of an academic cancer center, Sylvester physicians and scientists—all faculty of the Miller School of Medicine—are engaged in approximately 250 clinical trials and receive more than \$26 million annually in research grants.

AFFILIATED HOSPITALS

Licensed for more than 1,500 beds, **Jackson Memorial Hospital** is a teaching hospital for the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. It is home to many affiliated UM and Jackson programs, including the Ryder Trauma Center and the Miami Transplant Institute.

Holtz Children’s Hospital is one of the largest children’s hospitals in the southeastern United States. Staffed by UHealth/Miller physicians, Holtz Children’s Hospital specializes in research and treatment for a wide range of pediatric medical specialties, including pediatric diabetes, bone marrow transplantation, cardiology, infectious disease/immunology, allergies, gastroenterology, pulmonology, and transplantation of all solid organs, including pediatric multi-organ transplantation.

UHealth/Miller physicians work closely with the **Miami VA Healthcare System**. The Miami VA Healthcare System has provided general medical, surgical, and psychiatric services for our country’s veterans since 1968.

UHealth – University of Miami Health System and the Leonard M. Miller School of Medicine provide quality patient care to the South Florida community. The 100-acre medical campus in Miami’s Health District houses UHealth/Miller’s flagship hospital, University of Miami Hospital, and its two specialty hospitals: Bascom Palmer Eye Institute and Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center. It is also home to Jackson Memorial Hospital, Holtz Children’s Hospital, and the Miami VA Healthcare System.

DIRECTIONS

The UHealth/Miller medical campus is located in the area just north of downtown Miami. The following directions will bring you to the main access point to the campus, at the intersection of NW 12th Avenue and NW 14th Street. From there, you can proceed to a parking facility.

FROM THE NORTH

Take I-95 South. Exit on SR-836 West. Exit SR-836 West on NW 12th Avenue. Make a right on NW 12th Avenue. Continue north.

FROM THE SOUTH

Take I-95 North. Exit on SR-836 West. Exit SR-836 West on NW 12th Avenue. Make a right on NW 12th Avenue. Continue north.

FROM THE WEST

(Including Miami International Airport)
 Take SR-836 East and exit at NW 17th Avenue. Go north on NW 17th Avenue (a right turn). Cross the bridge and take the first right onto NW North River Drive. Continue straight on NW North River Drive through a slight right turn at the second traffic light. The next light is NW 12th Avenue and 14th Street.



VALET PARKING

Valet parking is available at the entrances to:

- University of Miami Hospital Main building on NW 12th Avenue at 15th Street
- University of Miami Hospital West building on NW 14th Street, between 12th and 14th Avenues
- Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center on NW 12th Avenue, north of 14th Street
- University of Miami Hospital and Clinics on NW 12th Avenue at 15th Street
- Bascom Palmer Eye Institute on NW 17th Street, west of 9th Avenue
- Jackson Health System Diagnostic Treatment Center on NW 19th Street, east of 12th Avenue

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The Metrorail Civic Center Station is adjacent to the medical center and within walking distance to any building on campus. In addition, the Miami Trolley provides a number of stops around campus and connects with Metrorail. The medical center is also serviced by Metrobus routes. UHEALTH SHUTTLE BUS

It’s easier than ever to visit UHealth physicians. Park at the Clinical Research Building garage (1120 NW 14th Street) for \$4 (half the regular price), then ride the air-conditioned shuttle bus. The bus driver will validate your parking ticket. UHealth shuttles go to University of Miami Hospital, Schoninger Research Quadrangle, Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center, and University of Miami Hospital and Clinics. They run approximately every 10 minutes and stop at designated entrances. This service is free of charge and operates between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m., Monday through Friday.
